Education is the gateway for these young Kenyan children to fulfill their dreams and become self-reliant. Holistic Education, offering a well-rounded educational experience including academic, psychological, spiritual, and co-curricular

activities like sports, arts, and creative opportunities, is the greatest gift we can give.

Growing up without parents is an experience that is hard to understand. These youngsters have grown up WITHOUT that special someone that is always there for them— to negotiate their need for education, medical care... a confidant to be by their side through the ups and downs of life. **THEY HAVE NO PARENTS.** They are missing that total commitment from a parent that loves them unconditionally.

NESP won't give these children their parents back but it CAN take one significant, life-changing issue off their plates—that of a quality Secondary Education.

The Children Served

The Nyumbani Educational Service Program (NESP) will serve qualified High School students from: the Nyumbani Children's Home- where abandoned, orphaned HIV+ children are given the best nutritional, medical, psychological, and spiritual care possible in blended home settings nurtured by a Mom or Uncle; the Nyumbani Village, Kitui- a self-sustaining, multi-generational environmental community where all residents participate in the tending of gardens and livestock and where the African culture can be passed on from the elders to the younger generation; and the Lea Toto Community Outreach Program in Nairobi- a community based program serving HIV+ children in the Nairobi area, so they can remain with caregivers in their communities.

At the end of their Standard 8 year (8th grade), each student takes a standardized exam. High School placement is based on their exam results. Students with higher test scores tend to matriculate to the government schools; lower test scorers tend to find a placement in the private schools. Most of the High School placements are boarding schools and the fees reflect that factor.
